8pm Friday 10 October 2025 The Ballad of Wallis Island

Cert 12 1hr 40mins

A modest lottery win takes eccentric music fan Charles (British cult comedian, Tim Key) to a windswept island, where his dream of reuniting his forgotten folk heroes blossoms into a funny, tender celebration of music and friendship.

Shades of 'Local Hero'.



### 8pm Friday 14 November 2025 The Queen of My Dreams

Cert 12A 1hr 39mins Subtitled Canadian born Azra has a strained relationship with her conservative Muslim mother. One thing they do

share is a love of Bollywood, which brings joyous moments to the film. After a death in the family Azra makes the journey to Pakistan, the film explores what this means for her and her mother and their relationship.



### 8pm Friday 12 December 2025 My Favourite Cake

Cert 12 1hr 37mins Subtitled Set in Tehran, this quietly subversive tragicomedy follows a 70-year-old widow who dares to seek romance and joy in a society that polices female desire.

A tender, bittersweet portrait of latelife longing and fleeting liberation.



#### 8pm Friday 9 January 2026 Good One

Cert 15 (2025) 1hr 30mins

On a weekend backpacking trip in the Catskills a 17 year old woman has to contend with her father and his best friend and all the baggage they bring with them. Then lines are crossed. A critically acclaimed insightful and compelling drama revolving around familial expectations and trust.



8pm Friday 23 January 2026 Vermiglio

Cert 15 1hr 19mins Subtitled

Set in Vermiglio, a scenic, remote, Italian mountain town in 1944. A respected school teacher has his quiet family life disrupted when a Sicilian deserter arrives. Discriminated against initially, the family take him in, resulting in a relationship with the eldest daughter. Then tragedy strikes.



8pm Friday 13 February 2026 Hard Truths

Cert 12 1hr 37mins

Veteran British director, Mike Leigh's dark saga of family life for contrasting London sisters Pansy - angry and depressed and Chantelle - sympathetic and cheerful. Centering on their deceased mothers 5th anniversary on Mothers Day and the ensuing dramas.



### 8pm Friday 13 March 2026 The Marching Band

Cert 15 1hr 43mins Subtitled

Diagnosed with leukemia, orchestral conductor Thiebault discovers he's adopted—and has a biological brother playing trombone in a struggling factory band.

As he steps in to lead them, music becomes the bond that unites and transforms two fractured lives.

## Film Screenings

Everyone is welcome at Reel People Films - you can come along as a guest for £5 and pay on the door or you can join us for the whole season of 8 Films - see Membership Information below.

All film screenings take place at Kilmersdon Village Hall, BA3 5TD on our giant screen with 5.1 surround sound in high definition or 4k when available.

Films start at 8pm but we open the doors and bar at 7.15pm so you can choose your seat and have a drink and a chat before the film.

The bar offers a selection of wines, beers, ciders and soft drinks.

There is parking directly outside the Hall together with some spaces on the old garage forecourt to the right side of the Hall. You can also park elsewhere in the village - there is a map showing the locations of some alternative parking places on our website.
