

Some things you might like to know

Everyone is welcome at Reel People Films - you can come along as a guest for £5 and pay on the door or you can join us for the whole season of 8 Films - see Membership Information below.

All film screenings take place at Kilmersdon Village Hall, BA3 5TD on our giant screen with 5.1 surround sound in high definition or 4k when available.

Films start at 8pm but we open the doors and bar at 7.15pm so you can choose your seat and have a drink and a chat before the film.

The bar offers a selection of wines, beers, ciders and soft drinks.

There is parking directly outside the Hall together with some spaces on the old garage forecourt to the right side of the Hall. You can also park elsewhere in the village - there is a map showing the locations of some alternative parking places on our website.

Membership of Reel People Films guarantees you a 'free seat' at all 10 main season films. The cost for the 2026-27 Season is £30 per person.

If you would like to join before the season opens or at the first or second film, there is an 'Early Bird' rate of £25 per person. There is also a special rate for young people (15 - 26 years) for £10 per person.
